* Tips for sermon preparation

- 1. Pray & meditate the text again & again & ask the Holy Spirit to lead you, control you & give you wisdom
- 2. The sermon must have experienced & Applied by the speaker
- 3. There should be only one main thought in the sermon repeat that again & again
- 4. Explain:-
 - who wrote
 - To whom
 - In which way
 - In which condition
 - To fill which purpose
- 5. Decide the form of the Sermon:-
 - Topical
 - Textual
 - Expository
 - Biographical
- 6. Its good if you start your sermon with an introductory illustration.
- 7. Start with a short introduction & about the value of what the listeners are going to listen.
- 8. Study according to the context.
 - Context is from where that particular theme started & till where it goes on
- 9. Use appropriate illustrations to prove your points
- 10. Prove your points with complete bible context.
 - Where else it is written!
- 11. Always use numbers for the main division points
- 12. Explain that how does this passage fit into the history of its time & of current time

- 13. Use at least three good translations to understand the passage closely & correctly
- 14. Focus on the key words & phrases in the passage
- 15. Bible is all about his story

(God's story)

- What we learn about God's character by this passage
- 16. What is the main Gospel truth in the passage?
 - That people should know
 - That they can be free

17. Application:

- -How this truth is applicable in our lives?
 - If they don't apply what will happen &
 - If they apply what will happen

(Application of the sermon is very important)

- 18. Include yourself in the application
- 19. be polite
 - The language & vocabulary that u are speaking must be good
- 20. be punctual & finish on time
- 21. Your body language & expressions should be in your control
- 22. Voice modulation is very important
 - Neither to high not to low
- 23. Fluency should be according to the listens
 - Neither too fast nor to slow
- 24. Pronunciation should be appropriate.
- 25. Eye contact should be with all.
- 26. Involve listeners with you.

- 27. One or two jokes are OK but,
 - Don't let the seriousness of the sermon go apart by too many jokes
- 28. Either Conclude with an illustration or repeat the points of main divisions.

29. Invitation:

- Invite people to pray that they can apply what they listen from the word of God
- 30. Sing a song related to your sermon
